MORNING WORSHIP FOCUS

One of the most powerful social control mechanisms is shame. When someone transgresses within a community, whether it be a family, a religious community, or a nation – shame can be a powerful tool to control the person or the climate. A good dose of shame can be healthy, but often shame is that which keeps a person enslaved to the power of the dark. Shame can be used to prop up the one's own self-righteousness and scapegoat the transgressor. God breaks that cycle in Jesus. As this text tells us, "he is not ashamed to call us brothers." It's not that we don't have things to be shameful about – for sure we do – but that God's forgiveness in the person of Christ frees us from the slavery to shame. We are welcomed into the family of God with open arms.


