Hearing assistance is available.

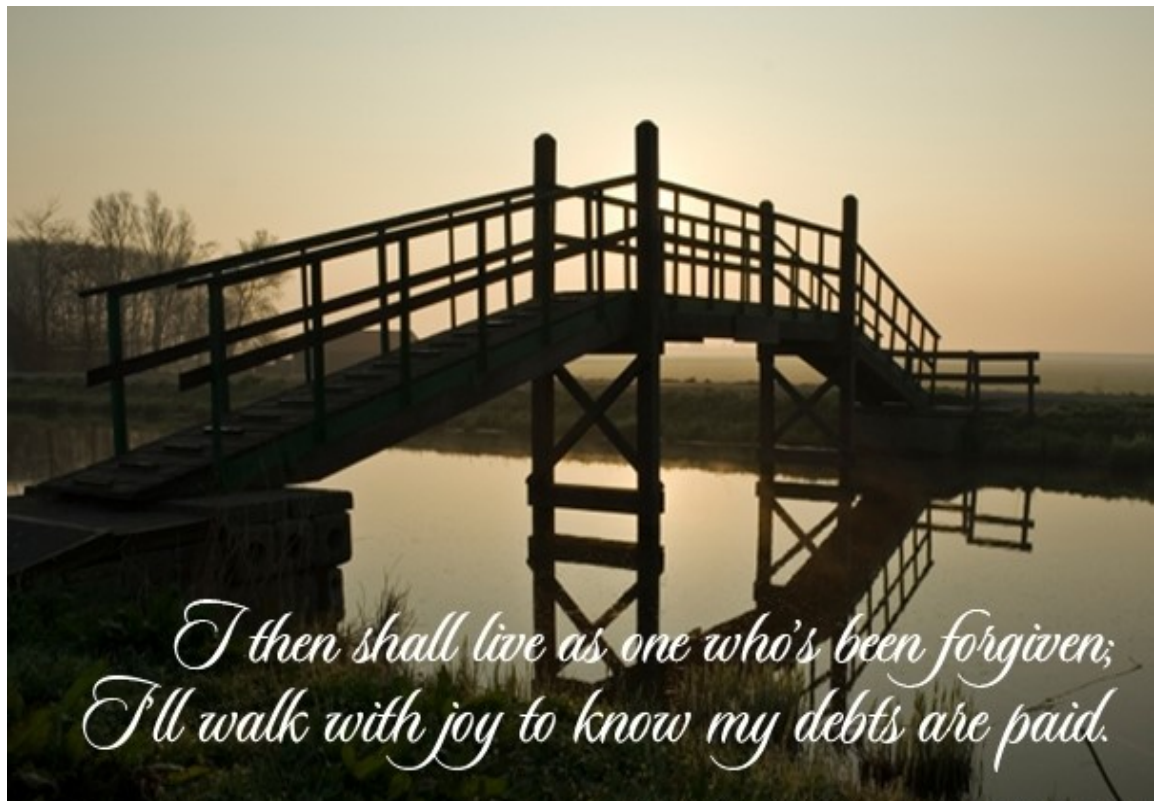
