We are so regularly shocked by the scandalous moral failure of prominent and gifted church leaders that increasingly we find it less and less shocking. Shocked or not, we should never be surprised by these sad developments, for they have been occurring regularly throughout the history of God's people, and they will continue to occur until the end of time. Today we take a long, hard look at the fall of King David in the Old Testament -- a man after God's own heart who yet somehow went off his spiritual rails so completely that he committed adultery and murder. The question that we can't help asking is "Why? How could this happen?" The answer is found in 2 Samuel 11, but it is as easy to overlook it in our own lives as it is in this scripture passage.

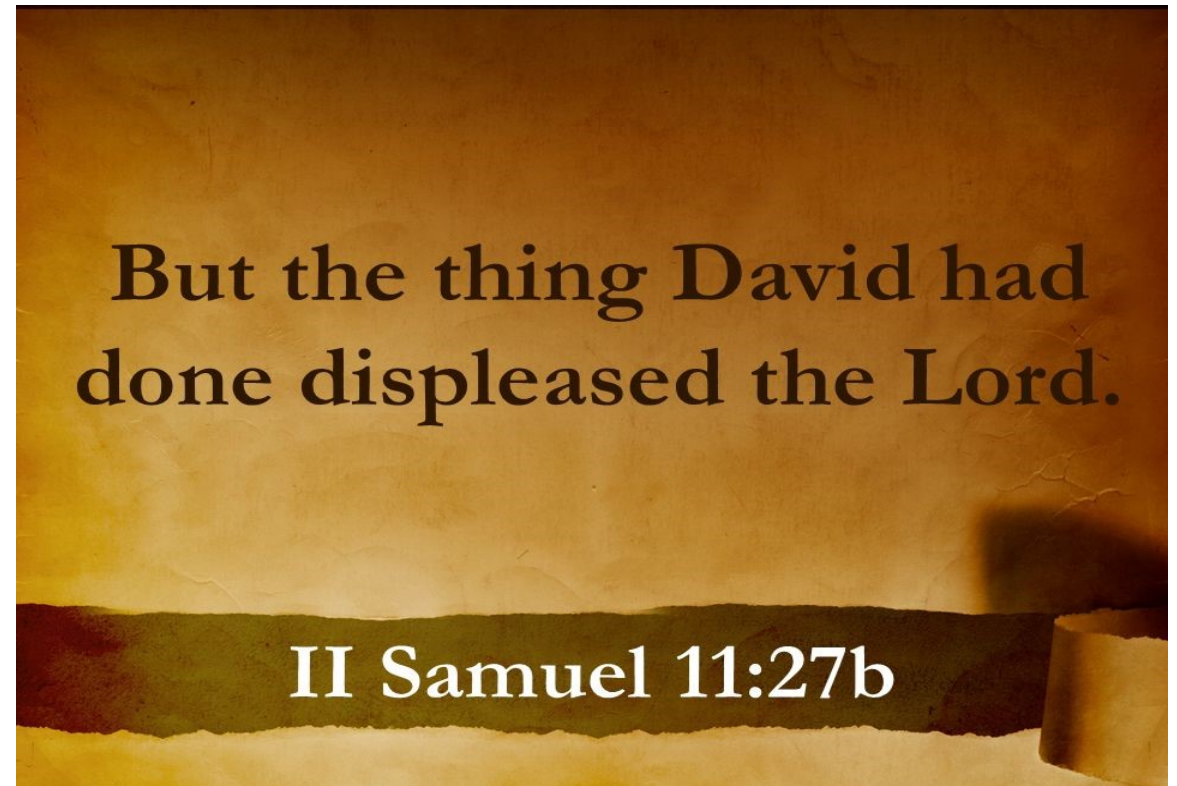
