David was in "denial" concerning his sin with Bathsheba, and that is a very bad place to be spiritually. Nathan the prophet understood the difficulty in breaking through this denial, and ingeniously found a way to do it with David. David confesses his sin and is forgiven, but he still has to live with the consequences of his poor choices for the rest of his life. There is recovery from sin through the forgiving grace of God, but David's spiritual recovery was not as complete as we would hope. This is painfully evident when we read the scriptural account of the rest of David's life; he was never again the man he once was. Our spiritual recovery as New Testament believers can and should be more complete as we find it necessary to go on after a serious spiritual fall.
