MORNING WORSHIP FOCUS

The Gideon's ministry is founded on deep convictions about the awesome power of God's Word, and vs. 12 certainly expresses the fact of it. But when the verse is read in context, it is clear that human beings have an awesome responsibility to hear that Word with open hearts and minds, and believe it in faith. God's Word is more than powerful enough to "take them apart" when they don't want to do that, and when God decides that's what he's going to do, it happens. But if God decides that's not what he's going to do, the resulting unbelief and hardness of heart is the fault of the human beings who refuse to believe, and they themselves bear full responsibility for it. This all brings to mind the famous "Five Points of Calvinism," which are easy to choke on, but in this passage the practical thrust is clear and necessary: We who have believed still have the responsibility to go forward actively seeking to hear God's voice as he speaks to us in many and various ways through Jesus Christ.
