### MORNING WORSHIP FOCUS

Most of us are familiar with Joshua's admonition in Joshua 24:15, "Choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve. . . . But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD." We may also remember that the people said at that time they would serve the Lord, and no doubt they fully intended to follow through on their commitment. But there was a problem, and Joshua (and Moses before him) knew what the problem was – even if the people themselves were blind to it. It is a problem which we often still have today as New Testament believers in Jesus Christ. We'll look at what that problem is, and how serious it can be for our eternal destiny. We'll also see that we have a solution to this problem as New Testament believers -- but the solution doesn't happen automatically; we must be active in implementing that solution.
