Worship Focus

The Holy Spirit was of course active in the individual hearts and lives of God's people in the Old Testament. Nonetheless, John says in ch. 7 of his Gospel that the Holy Spirit "was not yet" during Jesus' earthly ministry. John makes this puzzling parenthetical statement just after Jesus himself described how the day was coming when "streams of living water would flow" from within believers -- which John says is a reference to the Holy Spirit. In John chapters 14-17, just prior to Jesus' death, resurrection and ascension from the dead, Jesus spoke at length about all the changes that would occur in the personal interactions between the three persons of the Trinity, and between God and his people, when the Holy Spirit would come. We need to understand what really changed on Pentecost Day, and what the huge practical implications are for us today.

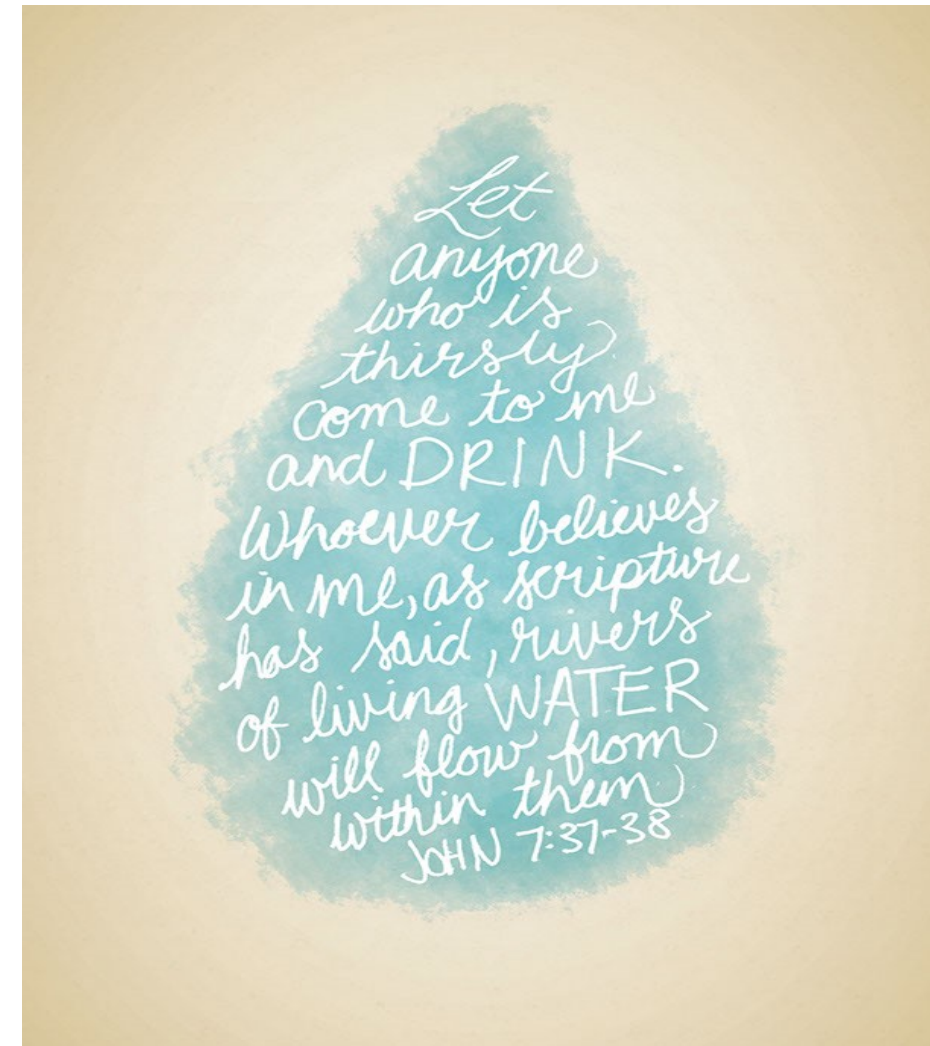
