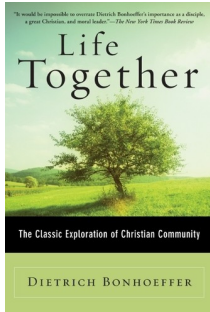


## Book Review

God's present purpose (Phil. 1:21) So stay he did; as a pastor he offered clandestine worship services and resisted the evil regime under Hitler.

Despite the daily danger, Bonhoeffer penned Life Together – a book on hospitality as ministry. He put this principle to the test when he lived and worked in a monastic community and when he was later imprisoned.

Every meal, every task, and every conversation, he taught, was an opportunity to show Christ to others, even under great stress or strain. An interesting read, and a great lesson to us, as we face our own stresses and strain.
