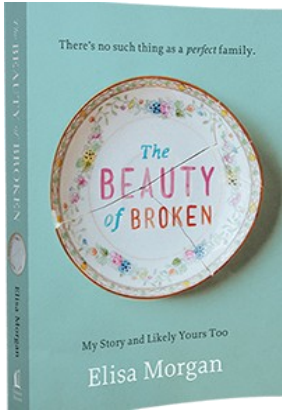


What's New in the Library

BOOKS:

The Beauty of Broken by Elisa Morgan— There's no such thing as a perfect family. Some are more



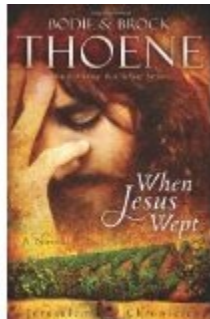
broken than others, but loving God and following Christ does not make us immune to problems and dysfunction within our families. Elisa offers hope as she shares her own personal

family struggles and what she has discovered through them.

As we are in the lenten season, with Easter occurring the first Sunday of next month, this may be a good time to read the first two books of the "Jerusalem Chronicles" by Bodie and Brock Thoene. Set during the time of Jesus, but rooted in the secrets of the Old Testament, this historical fiction captures the imagination while giving a better understanding of why Jesus did what He did:

When Jesus Wept (Book one) - The weight of Roman rule lay heavily on Israel. Then the Baptist cried,

"Prepare the way of the Lord", and wealthy David ben Lazarus began to hope - and become the beloved friend of the Lord of Life. On the day Laza-



rus died, his family mourned. But *When Jesus Wept*, the end of the story became the beginning!

Take This Cup (Book two) - Young Nehemiah, the child of Jewish exiles, is charged with a special mission. He is a disciple of



one of the Magi who'd traveled to Bethlehem 30 years before, and now charges Nehemiah to 'take this cup (chalice)' to Jerusalem. In time, his path leads to a pharisee

named Joseph of Arimathea . . . and to Jesus of Nazareth.
